

## Center Stage Dance Company Covid-19 Safety Protocol

- Masks on anyone in the studio.
- Frequent hand washing; will ramp up the frequency and the technique.
- An entrance protocol that would ask about fever, cough, or any other symptoms in the last 48 hours that would suggest that the student return home rather than attend class that day.
- No gathering in the lobbies; drop off at one of the three (3) entry doors and parents wait in their cars in the parking lots.
- We have three (3) lobbies and four (4) separate dance rooms, plus a student dressing room, and two (2) office areas. We are confident we can allocate space to our dancers to keep them at a safe distance from one another while they are in the building.
- We will limit the number of dancers and faculty in a dance room to support a distance of six (6) feet away from one another.
- We already have systems in place for disinfecting the mats and barres and floors. We will ramp them up to occur between each class.
- We also already have hand sanitizers in each dance room, the bathrooms, and the lobbies and offices. We will be particularly attentive to making sure they are always full.
- Dance supplies, such as yoga blocks and mats, hand weights, exercise balls, etc., previously used by many groups, will be distributed only if we feel we can manage the disinfection properly. Otherwise, we will require that each dancer have their own set of supplies that they bring with them each time.
- We will institute a policy of only one person in the double bathroom at a time and no queues outside the doors of either the double or single bathrooms.
